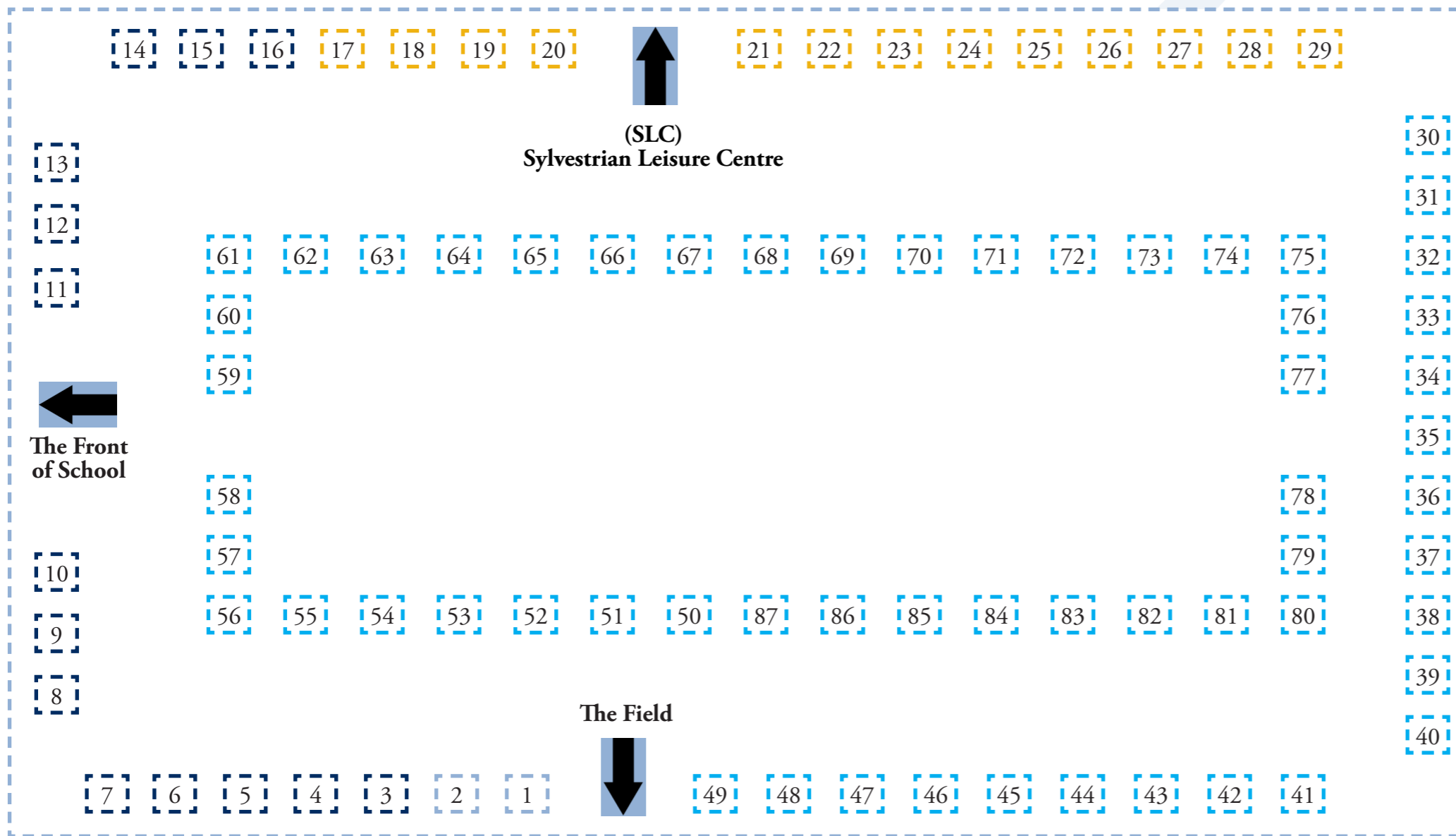

## Getting the most from today's Higher Education and Careers Fair

We are delighted to welcome representatives from higher education and industry to Forest today. The exhibitors are prepared to answer any questions you have, so be sure to take advantage of the opportunity.

Whilst it may be tempting to simply ask all the employers in the Fair about how much money they earn, or to ask all the university representatives where all their students go to party, we recommend that you give a little more thought to your line of questioning today.

Remember that the exhibitors are all experts in their fields and if they like you (your approach, attitude and what you ask) they may be prepared to give you more than just a prospectus and a branded pen. Everything from invaluable university application advice to work experience opportunities are up for grabs.

**Here are some points to consider before you approach the exhibitors today.**

### Forest School's Sixth Form (Stand 1)

Forest is truly a London school and our pupils come from all over the city and beyond. We are proud of the fact that pupils join Forest at 16 every year, and that our pupil and parent body reflects the diversity of the city.

Our Sixth Formers take the Forest Diploma - with A Levels at its academic core, the Forest Diploma has been developed with input from leading universities and employers.

The Forest Diploma is for any pupil, of any background, as is admission to the School. Through the award of Scholarships and Bursaries, pupils may join our Sixth Form without ever having to pay fees.

### Employers (Stands 3 - 29)

Representatives from industry will be only too happy to discuss the things that have brought them success in their careers. Be sure to ask about how they got to where they are today and about the things they did when they were your age – was getting a degree important? Or not? What might they describe as their strongest skill?

These people are an invaluable source of information and are here today to share that information with you. Ask nicely and they may put you in contact with someone who could help with work experience. Ask very nicely (and impress them with your well thought-out questions), and they themselves may be able to help.

Whoever you plan on speaking to today, don't leave the Sports Hall without first asking all the questions you want answers to...and at least one branded pen...

### Universities (Stands 30 - 87)

Rather than focussing only on grade requirements, remember to ask about what else you can do to strengthen your application. Will you need any work experience, for example? How do they view co-curricular activities? Will you be interviewed as part of the admissions process?

If you are thinking of moving into university halls, you might start by asking about where the residences are actually located. Some student halls may be miles from campus whilst others offer accommodation on-site. Have you ever attempted to warm up baked beans in a kettle? If so, you may also wish to ask whether fully-catered facilities are available.

It is also important to consider what you can do outside of lectures and classes. Be sure to ask about university clubs and societies.
