What consolidation looks like in this subject	<p>You use different time frames. Use different types of verbs. You can use different verbs of opinion: <i>me apasiona, me preocupa, me importa</i>. You can use absolute superlatives: <i>muchísimo, importantísimo</i>. You use different connectives: <i>además, sin embargo, sobre todo, no obstante, por ejemplo</i>. You can use sentences with <i>cuando, donde, si para + infinitive</i>. You can use indirect object pronouns. You are starting to feel confident when using high level phrases.</p>
Examples of Homework	<p>Reading from Active Learn. Listening from Active Learn. Grammar from Active Learn. Vocabulary retrieval from Active Learn. Reading comprehension tasks and “Who says what” activities all completed in the target language. Learning and consolidating vocabulary and grammar. Preparing speaking questions for oral assessments. Writing short paragraphs with opinions and justifications. Listening comprehension tasks. Grammar activities such as practicing verb conjugations or adjectival agreements.
