## Learning Aims and Curriculum Intent:

In Year 8 we intend to continue to use Spanish to reflect the world pupils live in, using contexts familiar to them in their everyday lives and teaching them the vocabulary that they need to communicate with young Spanish people of their own age on topics that interest and stimulate them. They are introduced to young Spanish people and given insight into the everyday life and culture of Spain and other Spanish-speaking countries, encouraging intercultural understanding. We aspire to give our pupils a real taste of Spanish culture, which enable to bring language learning to life and establish excellent Spanish pronunciation and spelling, as key sounds of Spanish are introduced using phonics.
