Super-curricular enrichment and scholarly extension	Read: Astérix Le Gaulois, TinTin, L'Etranger (graphic novel), Les Misérables (graphic novel), Arsène Lupin – gentleman-cambrioleur, – all available in the school library with many other popular French books and parallel texts. Watch: Lupin on Netflix, Il a déjà tes yeux on Netflix. There are also a huge variety of French films available in the school library. Listen: CoffeeBreak French podcasts – ensure that you choose the right level for you; music by Stromae. Visit: Nice on the Year 10/11 French Trip – spend 5 days in Nice living with a French family and attending a language school every morning and going on cultural excursions every afternoon. Also consider visiting L'Institut Français (London), The National Gallery (London), any exhibitions taking place in London.
